61st Annual Regatta

08/22/2000

Three down and three to go. Fishing Bay hosted the Southern Chesapeake Leukemia Cup 23-24 June and the Annual One Design Regatta 12-13 August immediately following the Lightning North American with 21 Masters, 10 Ladies and 12 Juniors. The Lightning Regatta ran from 7-11 August. A full week by any standards.

For Saturdays races we were blessed with excellent conditions with 108 boats registered. The Regatta was run jointly with the Flying Scot Capitol District Championships with 20 boats joined on the outside course by 14 Front Runners, 12 Hamptons and 12 Mobjacks. On the mid course we had 10 Albacores, 3 JY-15's, 13 Lasers, 6 420's and 3 Bytes. Inside Fishing Bay we had a total of 14 Optis, 4 in the red, 3 in the green and 7 in the blue fleets. Happily we got in four races on Saturday on both out-of-the bay courses while the Optis got in five. Supper was ready almost as soon as the boats returned to shore but there was minimal use of the dance floor as few sailors had any energy left.

Sunday started off looking very promising at day break but by 8.30 the rain had settled in and we had more thunder and lightning than most of us choose to go out in. After two postponements racing was abandoned at 11.45. Now we have three more major regattas to look forward to, the Stingray Light Regatta for off-shore boats 1-3 September, the One Design Indian Summer Regatta 7-8 October and the US Laser Masters Regatta 13-15 October with many other racing and cruising opportunities before that.

In the Laser class most of the usual suspects were racing elsewhere, or heaven forbid taking a day off. The Toms brothers, Lewis and Mike both sailing old boats with even older sails finished first and second, with one or the other beating out a late arrival, David Porter, in the two races he sailed. Jere Dennison took an easy first in the first race but tired and after several capsizes retired in the third race. The race committee kept the tiring/tired fleets out for a fourth race, but earned a lot of gratitude by making it short and finishing towards the club. The races scheduled for Sunday were washed out as noted above.

June Laser News

An e-mail posting by Ted Morgan of Severn Sailing Association was posted on the club bulletin board ([and this website](#)). It describes the exciting ride Laser sailors had at Wrightsville Beach for the Atlantic Coast Championship on May 13 hosted by Carolina YC. It includes some graphic descriptions of downwind and reaching in 20-25 knots and five foot waves. Coupled with some great sailing conditions during our first Frostbite series this means that Laser sailors have had much better sailing in 2000 than most other fleets. For the first Wednesday night sailing event, on May 10, we had more than 20 knots from the south which made getting off the beach a challenge. On May 24 we had a record seven Lasers out including Mark Cycotte as a first timer, and two ladies, one a regular and one we are working on.

Back to the Carolina YC on May 13, there were 58 full rigs and 23 radials. What was most noticeable about the younger set were some very light weights. One of the featherweights, who understandably came in early as the wind and waves increased for the second and third races, responded to my "do you weigh 100 lbs. yet?" question with a "yes Sir, 101!". And I saw more old hulls and five digit sail numbers that day than I have in a long time. Perhaps the lessons from these observations are that you don't have to be 130 lbs. to sail a Laser Radial and that an older hull makes a good starter boat. The club owns a radial lower mast and radial sail so we can help you try out this growing class.

One of the reasons we are attracted to the Laser is because of the thrill ride you get from a scream reach in 20 knots of breeze. Add 5 foot swells and a bit more velocity and you've just placed yourself inside the gates of Laser heaven. Several of us got to take a peak this past weekend during the Atlantic Coast Champs held in the Atlantic Ocean off the sandy shores of Wrightsville Beach, North Carolina and host, the Carolina Yacht Club.

58 full rigs and 23 radials were on hand for the experience. Saturday's forecast called for highs in the 90's with a southeasterly sea breeze of 15-20 knots. We got every bit of 20, and then some.

The waves were tremendous, often breaking over top of competitors as they worked upwind. The trips downwind were beyond the verbal YAHOO!!! Riding down the backside of these swells was incredible. You'd start off being slowly lifted to the top of the crest, providing you with a remarkable view of all the carnage in front of you. Then came the acceleration and lift off. Half the boat, centerboard to bow, airborne, water surging out of the centerboard trunk and into your cockpit. Your competitors then disappear. All you can see is the tips of their masts.

Praying for survival, you are then dealt the hand of the green monster; a wall of water representing the wave in front of you that is about to pitch pole your boat. Your vision is obstructed as you feverishly try to pop the bow up to catch the next ride.....fantastic!

Three races were sailed in these spectacular conditions. Sunday was more Chesapeake like, 8-10 knots, with marginal surfing, allowing for 2 more races.

Sorry I don't have complete results. All I can say is that the top spot was being contested by Clay Johnson, Mark Eldred, and Kurt Taulbee. Those making the trip from the Bay area included Alain Vincey, David Hazlehurst, and Jon Deutsch from Fishing Bay; Ted Morgan, Karen Long, and Nick Van Wagoner from SSA; and George Panayides from Hampton.

George continues to be the man to beat, putting up a very strong performance that netted him 8th overall. Karen won top female, while Ted (20th) successfully fought back the youth movement, aka Nick (22nd), for at least one more week.

One bad luck/good luck story. George's car blew a belt 2 hours from the club Friday night leaving him stranded on the banks of I-95. No less than 60 seconds after opening the hood, Karen comes storming to the rescue. Two hours later George's car is in the shop, his boat is on Karen's trailer, and they are back on the road to the regatta. Talk about

One Design Ice Breaker Day

April 26, 1997

Six Lasers joined by three Front Runners, two Mobjacks, one JY 15 and one Byte made some 6-8 starts within shouting distance of the Club Beach at the One Design Icebreaker on 26 April.

Conditions were as near perfect as any of us could have hoped for and only the two younger sailors tested the water temperature and this barely slowed them down.

The sailing was followed by a showing of the official ISAF Centennial Olympics video, one of the advertised attractions. The other, copies of the Winter issue of the Laser Sailor will be provided to attendees and those racers who had conflicts. This issue has a particularly useful article on tactics and sail trim as it takes you around a triangular race course which could even be of value to those who sail boats with more than a main.

As most of us were leaving we saw the Garrett Byte being readied for launch, and we suspect Parker's late arrival was either because he'd been tethered or was waiting for the wind to come up. And we even trained an old Sunfish sailor how to rig and race his Laser, and by the last race he was sailing competitively. We only hope he got back to Richmond in time to make his peace on the home front.

And finally anyone, regardless of prior experience, will be welcomed with open arms so please join us on 10 May for the first Spring series regatta.

Three down and three to go. Fishing Bay hosted the Southern Chesapeake Leukemia Cup 23-24 June and the Annual One Design Regatta 12-13 August immediately following the Lightning North American with 21 Masters, 10 Ladies and 12 Juniors. The Lightning Regatta ran from 7-11 August. A full week by any standards.

For Saturdays races we were blessed with excellent conditions with 108 boats registered. The Regatta was run jointly with the Flying Scot Capitol District Championships with 20 boats joined on the outside course by 14 Front Runners, 12 Hamptons and 12 Mobjacks. On the mid course we had 10 Albacores, 3 JY-15's, 13 Lasers, 6 420's and 3 Bytes. Inside Fishing Bay we had a total of 14 Optis, 4 in the red, 3 in the green and 7 in the blue fleets. Happily we got in four races on Saturday on both out-of-the bay courses while the Optis got in five. Supper was ready almost as soon as the boats returned to shore but there was minimal use of the dance floor as few sailors had any energy left.

Sunday started off looking very promising at day break but by 8.30 the rain had settled in and we had more thunder and lightning than most of us choose to go out in. After two postponements racing was abandoned at 11.45. Now we have three more major regattas to look forward to, the Stingray Light Regatta for off-shore boats 1-3 September, the One Design Indian Summer Regatta 7-8 October and the US Laser Masters Regatta 13-15 October with many other racing and cruising opportunities before that.

In the Laser class most of the usual suspects were racing elsewhere, or heaven forbid taking a day off. The Toms brothers, Lewis and Mike both sailing old boats with even older sails finished first and second, with one or the other beating out a late arrival, David Porter, in the two races he sailed.
